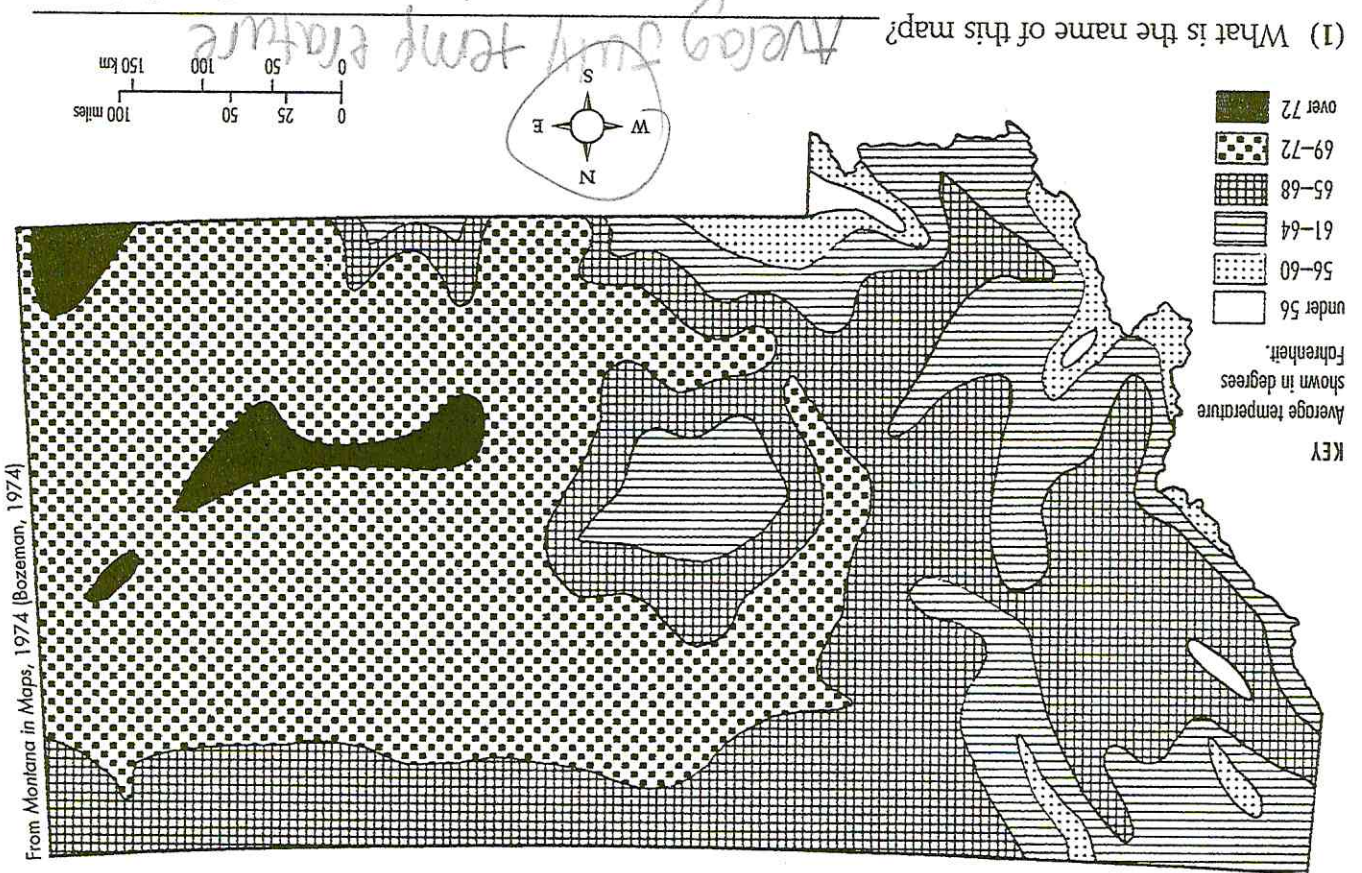


CHAPTER 1 / Map Skills: Reading a Map
